

Guía para el examen de ingreso al Profesorado de Inglés Inst. Superior Ntra. Sra. de la Paz



¡Bienvenido/a al Profesorado de Inglés del ISNSLP!

Para comenzar con tu formación académica deberás rendir y aprobar un examen de ingreso que constatará tu nivel de inglés. El nivel requerido es *upper intermediate* (usuario independiente, B1+ o B2: según CERF).

El examen constará de dos partes:

- Un examen escrito en el cual se evaluarán tus conocimientos en las siguientes áreas: Reading Comprehension, Use of English y Writing.
- Un examen oral tipo entrevista.

Los exámenes son mutuamente eliminatorios, por lo tanto deberás aprobar ambas instancias para ingresar a nuestro profesorado.

A continuación, encontrarás los temas que serán evaluados y el link para poder acceder al cuadernillo de preparación para el examen.

Temas:

- All tenses (past, present and future) and time expressions.
- Indirect questions and revision of questions
- Reported speech and reporting verbs
- Modality: obligation, necessity, duty, advice, ability, permission, prohibition, possibility, no obligation (must / have to / need / should / ought to / can /could / may / might / be able to /needn't/mustn't/can't / couldn't) and related verbs (be required to /be supposed to / manage to / succeed in / be allowed to / be likely to)
- ‘wish / if only’ + simple past / past perfect; ‘wouldn’t’ + infinitive; ‘should’ + infinitive / perfect infinitive; ‘could’ + perfect infinitive; ‘had better’ + infinitive and ‘rather’.
- Conditionals: All conditional forms, mixed conditionals, as long as, unless, provided/ing that.
- Defining and non-defining relative clauses
- Modal verbs of deduction in the past
- Future perfect and future perfect continuous

- Linkers: On the one hand, on the other hand, to sum up, interestingly, as mentioned above, in order to, so as to, so that, therefore, though.
- Question tags
- Habits in the present and in the past: Would (revision and contrast of used to - be/get used to)
- Preferences: 'd rather, 'd prefer, To be into/keen on/etc.
- Passive voice and causative use of have/get
- Comparatives and superlatives and double comparative: the...the

- A description of a person, place, object or event
- A review
